#### **DELIVERY SCAMS DURING THE HOLIDAYS**

Online purchases and package deliveries skyrocket during the holiday season. Here's some scams to be aware of and how to protect yourself.

You may receive a text message or an email from the post office or delivery company that ask you to reschedule a delivery or pay a small delivery fee. These may look legitimate but if you click, you may download malware that gives con artists access to personal information or passwords.

In another version you may receive a message from what appears to be a delivery driver looking for your home with a number to contact them. If you call the number, the scammer will ask you to confirm personal details, including your name address and possibly your credit card information.

To avoid delivery scams, keep track of your deliveries. It will be harder for scammers to fool you if you know what packages you are expecting, from what companies, and when. It's also good to know delivery company policies. Be leery of unsolicited messages, especially if you never signed up for text alerts. Lastly, never give sensitive personal information to strangers.

#### BEWARE OF SPOOFED WEBSITES TOO!

Online shopping can be a little overwhelming, and it can feel like there's an infinite number of retailers to choose from. Try to stick to websites and stores that you're already familiar with to do your shopping – but be aware that spoofed websites exist.

Spoofed websites are made to look just like real sites from legitimate companies. In reality, they're a tool used by cyber criminals to steal your time, money and identity. Fortunately, these websites are often riddled with mistakes that you can identify if you're looking for them.

- You should be suspicious if the pricing on a website is too good to be true.
- Be on the lookout for red flags, like pixelated or blurry images, difficult to navigate pages and typos. The website may also be missing a return policy or a privacy policy.
- Be aware if the website is asking for too much information. No website will ever ask for your SIN number, your mother's maiden name, or any other sensitive information outside of the norm.
